 homeowner's association, is amended to include all of the following as such and provide for cost sharing
 for the maintenance on the following basis:
 - Winding Creek Subdivision 54.64%
 - Emerald Green Subdivision 21.03%
 - 3. Clearstone Subdivision and Clearstone Subdivision No. 2 24.33%
- The parties to this Amendment to the Agreement hereby agree to assume all of the rights and responsibilities as set forth in that Agreement as though such rights and responsibilities are fully set forth in this Amendment and as such agree to be bound by all of the terms and conditions of that Agreement as though more fully set forth herein.
